## Weekly Update October 1st to October 7th 2016

Songbird catches have significantly slowed this week, making way for owl banding to finish off the season. A few neat catches include a few more Golden-crowned Kinglets and a Fox Sparrow! We have mostly late migrants and resident birds left now. It has been nice to see our Rough-legged Hawks starting to appear, however. These hawks are one of our latest migrating raptors.

Owl banding has been going well this week, with captures as high as 28 in one night! There have been only a few small hiccups, primarily that we seem to be catching a number of Northern Flying Squirrels this year. While they seem cute, they can do quite a bit of damage to the mist nets, and I have had to repair four shelf lines this week. At least it has not stopped us from catching lots of owls!

This week we had the first solid frost after a night of -9 degrees Celsius. Frost was thick on every branch and on the thick spider webs covering every tree. It may indeed turn out to be a very cold winter.
