American Tree Sparrows!

Fall Songbird Migration comes to an end this week. With 49 birds of 8 different species captured, biologists were sad but content with this year's numbers. A total of 50 species were captured during this 2019 Fall migration, which is fairly decent for the station. Highlight species from this week include Ruby-crowned Kinglets and Golden-crowned Kinglets!

Many Tundra Swans and dark morphed Rough-legged Hawks were seen flying around in the last 7 days, as well as a small flock of Snow Buntings! Winter is just around the corner it would seem.

On one particular day we caught 21 American Tree Sparrows, as well as sightings of Snow Geese, Shrikes and Lapland Longspurs flying overhead!

Owl Migration continues to increase this week with a total of 104 captures! 101 Northern Saw-whet Owls were caught, as well as another Long-eared Owl, and the highlight for our biologists.... A GREAT HORNED OWL!!! This handsome bird was caught in our long-eared owl net and is the second Great Horned Owl we have caught in the last two years! What a magnificent creature!!
