

Weekly Update September 1st to 7th

Fall migration monitoring is fully underway this week, with staff banding 126 birds of 24 species. We have been catching mixed warbler flocks more frequently this week, mainly consisting of Myrtle and Orange-crowned Warblers. Highlights of the week include a Yellow-bellied Flycatcher, Grey-cheeked Thrush, Connecticut Warbler and a Bay-breasted Warbler! However, this week was fairly slow, with bad weather looming over us while banding most days.



Long-eared Owl

BBO staff has been busy with odds and ends around the bird observatory. In the past week, we have repaired a fence around the natural area, refilling bird feeders, and installing fencing around the new staff bunkhouse, Raven's Roost.

Thanks to the visitors and volunteers that came out this week assisting BBO including; John, Jerry, Melissa, Shauna, Jana, Steve and the Girl Guides!

With the onset of cool temperatures this week, we have seen the departures of some birds including Ruby-throated Hummingbirds, and arrivals of others including Snow Geese and Owls! Owl banding started this week and so far, we have caught three Long-eared Owls and four Northern Saw-whet Owls! The start of the month is typically slow while migration begins to pick up, but we are very excited with the first week of owl migration.
